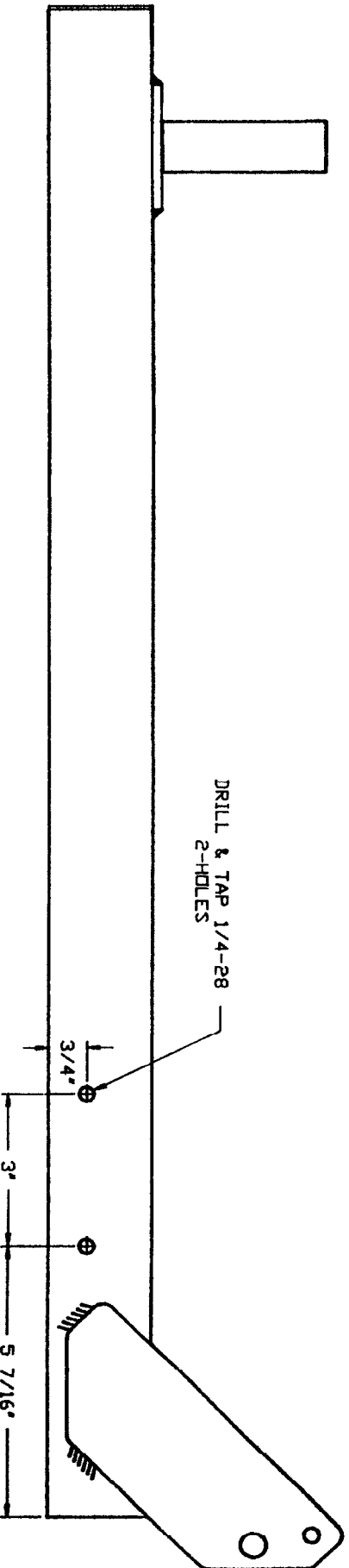
Installation of Alpha Variac & Linkage on Balco 3 Deck Cable System
(October 4, 1993)

The Take-up Assy can be mounted using existing holes. There may be a $1/16$ " misalignment in the mount holes which can be corrected by filing out the mount hole in the Upper Take-up Bracket.

The holes to mount the Variac to the bottom arm must be added. A drill, tap, and a drawing showing correct hole locations have been included.

Also included is a set of Alpha System manuals. Use the parts manual as an aid in mounting the new components and for ordering replacement parts in the future. All of the components provided are stock Alpha System parts except the electrical jumper. The operation manual contains adjustment procedures which may be useful.

The electrical jumper will connect the 9-pin receptacle on the Variac to the existing socket in the base of the column. The 4-pin receptacle on the Variac, which is the Table Port on the Alpha System, will not function on your system.
