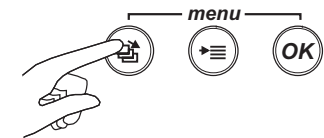
CP650 Software Update Guide

What Is My Current Software Version?

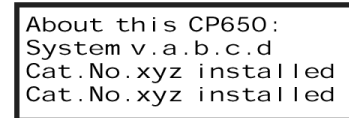
The version number of the operating software in your CP650 shows briefly during the CP650 power-up sequence. You can also check the version number by following this procedure:

- Press the left **menu** button multiple times to step through the menus to **About this CP650**.

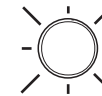
Note: You can also press and hold the left menu button while rotating the front-panel fader knob clockwise to step through the menu items.



- **About this CP650** has three menu screens. The first screen displays the version number of the installed operating system software on the second line of the display.



- Press the illuminated format button to return to the top menu screen.



What Tools Do I Need?

- You will need a PC running the CP650 Setup Software.

Note: Earlier versions of CP650 **Setup** software are not fully compatible with current versions of CP650 **Operating System** software. If you are running setup software prior to the version contained on this CD, you must uninstall it, then install the current version on your PC.

Updating CP650 Operating System Software

- From the **Software** tab on this CD, click **CP650**. Select the **Operating System Software** link. When asked, save the file to your PC hard disk drive. (Note: The “File Download” dialog box may appear behind the window you are viewing.)
Alternately, browse this CD to locate the most current **cp650vxxxx.bin** file and copy it to your PC hard disk drive.
- Connect the PC to the CP650 Cinema Processor using a serial cable connected to the CP650 serial data connector on the front or rear panel.
- Run the CP650 Setup Software on the PC.
- From the **Action** menu, choose **Connect** or click on the connect icon.
- If prompted, choose to **Retrieve** cinema processor settings.
- From the **Action** menu, choose **Update Software...**
- If desired, you may save the newly retrieved settings to disk.
- Browse for and select the software update file (.bin) saved above.
- Select **Update Now**.

Caution: *This process should not be interrupted. If the CP650 main power is turned off before the software update has been completed successfully, the CP650 will become inoperable and the Cat. No. 797 flash memory module must be replaced.*

If the physical cable connection between the CP650 and the computer is opened during the update process, the CP650 displays:

Update Failed!
Reconnect and update
Software to proceed.

If this occurs, restore the cable connection, reconnect the CP650 Setup Software, and restart the software update process.

- When the update has finished, the CP650 will automatically restart.
- Next, the PC software will automatically reconnect, send the cinema processor settings back, and remain connected.
- The update process is now complete. The CP650 will contain updated software while retaining the original alignment settings.

Updating CP650 Setup Software

- **Uninstall any earlier version** of the Setup software using the Add/Remove Programs icon in the Windows control panel.
- From the **Software** tab on this CD, click **CP650**. Select the **Setup Software** link. Save the file to your PC hard disk drive then double-click to begin the installation, or run the installation program directly from this CD. (Note: The “File Download” dialog box may appear behind the window you are viewing.)

Note: If you see a popup window describing uninstallaion of the current application, then you have not successfully uninstalled the earlier version of the setup software. You may continue, but will need to repeat this step to complete the installation

Alternatively, browse this CD to locate the **cp650setup_x_x_x_x.exe** file (x represents the current version number). Double-click to begin installation.
