
## **POWER SUPPLY DIODE CARD**


PS DIODE CARD KIT # 4450

#### **Purpose:**

The power supply diode card was added to prevent a failed power supply from damaging the two remaining power supplies.



- in Figure A.
- 3. Rotate the clamps around the tray spacer rods and tighten the 5/16" nuts. The diode card should now be secure.
- Remove the two 3 ½" purple wires from the existing lower, middle, and upper power supply 4. connections, terminal 4 and discard. Pull the 19" purple wire from terminal 4 on the upper power supply and put it into terminal one on the diode card.
- 5. Put the other 3 purple wires from the diode card term 2, 3, 4, into terminal 4 of the appropriate power supply as shown in Figure B.
